

## Tie Breaking

If there are ties in points at the end, the two places that are tied split the money from the two levels that are tied. It is like track scoring so you may come in third and end up not winning any money because people ahead of you are tied. If we just split the money from each level in a tie then first place could theoretically get less money than second or third. If you are still confused (yes dad, you are still confused, read on), take a look at the following examples:

A. Two people tie for first and second is a point behind:

1st (tie) - 45% of money  
1st (tie) - 45% of money  
3rd - 10% of money  
4th - thanks for playing

B. First is ahead by a few points and there is a 4 way tie for 2nd:

1st - 60% of money  
2nd (tie) - 10% of money  
2nd (tie) - 10% of money  
2nd (tie) - 10% of money  
2nd (tie) - 10% of money  
6th - thanks for playing

C. First is ahead of second by a point and there are two people tied for third:

1st - 60% of money  
2nd - 30% of money  
3rd (tie) - 5% of money  
3rd (tie) - 5% of money
